

"Hangout" Battery Bag

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"Hangout" Battery Bag

"Hangout's" are a feature of Google Plus. They allow people to make free online video conferences (like Skype only better). If you're using your cell phone to join a Hangout, then you may run out of battery power sooner than you want. We've created this bag to store an external battery pack. Attach a carabiner and you can clip this to your belt loop, backpack or tripod.

SUPPLIES:

Yarn: *Sugar'n Cream* –Worsted Weight (4)
INDIGO – 1 skein (20 g)
VANILLA BOUQUET – remnant (2 g)

Hook: H / 8 / 5.00 mm

Needle: Yarn Needle for sewing

ABBREVIATIONS:

Ch = chain

Dc = double crochet

Dec = decrease; crochet two stitches together

Hdc = half double crochet

Rnd = round; work in the round

Sc = single crochet

Sc dec = single crochet decrease; single crochet two stitches together

Sc inc = single crochet increase; two single crochet in the same stitch

Sl st = slip stitch

St(s) = stitch(es)

Trc = treble (triple) crochet

instructions = repeat the instructions written between the ** the number of times indicated after the second *

Yarn Craft: Crochet

Skill Level: Easy a a a a

Project Type: Bag

Size: 3 ½" wide x 1" deep x 4" tall

Gauge: Hook: H – 4 sc & 4 rows = 1"

BAG INSTRUCTIONS

Indigo

Hook: H

q Ch 13

q **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc across. (12)

q **Row 2-4:** Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (12)

q **Rnd 5:** Turn to side of Rows 1-4. Work 4 sc across. (4)

Turn to foundation ch. Working in back loop only, sc across. (12)

Turn to side of Rows 1-4. Work 4 sc across. (4)



"Hangout" Battery Bag (continued)

Turn to Row 4. Working in back loop only, sc across. (12)

q **Rnd 6-8:** Sc around. (32)

q **Rnd 9-10:** Ch 3 (count as first st). Trc around. Join with a sl st. (32)

q **Rnd 11-13:** Sc around. (32)

q **Rnd 14:** 2 sc dec, 12 sc, 2 sc dec, 12 sc. (28)

q **Rnd 15:** Sc dec, 12 sc, sc dec, 12 sc. (26)

q **Rnd 16:** Ch 2 (This creates a small hole for a carabiner), skip the sl sts just made, 2 sl st. Leave remaining sts unworked. (2)

q Finish off and weave in ends.

"HANGOUT" APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS

Vanilla Bouque

Hook: H

q **Ch 9**

q **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc across. (8)

q **Row 2-6:** Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (8)

q **Rnd 7:** Turn to side of Rows 1-6. Sc inc, 4 sc, sc inc. (8)

Turn to foundation ch. Sc across. (8)

Turn to side of Rows 1-6. Sc inc, 5 sc, sc inc. (9)

Turn to Row 6. 3 sc, ch 5, sl st into 3rd ch from hook. Trc into same sts as last sc made. Dc, hdc, 4 sc, sl st.

q Finish off leaving a long tail for sewing.

"HANGOUT CAMERA" APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS

Indigo

Hook: H

q **Ch 6**

q **Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc across. (5)

q **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn. Sc across. (5)

Ch 3 (count as first st), turn the work. Hdc in 3rd ch from hook. Ch 3 (count as a st). Sl st into same space as hdc. (3)

q **Row 3:** Sc across. (5)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pin then sew "Hangout Camera" to "Hangout" Appliqué. Weave in ends.
2. Pin then Sew "Hangout" Applique to front of Bag leaving one side open to allow business cards to slide in (optional). The right side is left open in the Bag pictured. Note that the Ch 2 hole from Rnd 16 is on the same side as the opening for the business card – so that the cards don't fall out when the Bag is clipped to something (in the picture I have the carabiner on the wrong side).

Note: As you sew Applique pieces, that's when you can help edges be more crisp or more curvy as needed.





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
