Dish clothes are great projects for beginners and also fun quick projects that you can make on the go. We've include three of our favorite dishies in this pattern.

When making these as gifts, you may want to consider the recipient. Do you think they would like bright bold colors? Or would they want a light color that they can bleach?

Color aside, hand knit dishies make great gifts because they are practical yet fun.

SUPPLIES:

Yarn: Cotton: Medium Worsted Weight (4)

Needle: 7 or 8

Needle: Yarn Needle for sewing

CHART ABBREVIATIONS:

O = yarn over

2 = knit 2 together

WRITTEN ABBREVIATIONS:

K = knit

KFB = knit increase in front and back

K2Tog = knit 2 together

P = purl

PssO = decrease, pass slipped stitch over

Sts = stitches

YO = yarn over

Note: For the pictured dishies, when k2tog was called for we used the pssO decrease instead.

It's simple. It's square. And this dishie will clean up in no time!

Want splash of color in the kitchen? Use bright colors or variegated yarn to spice things up.

Yarn Craft: Knit
Skill Level: Easy a a a a
Project Type: Dish cloth
Size: 7 ½ inches square



- q **Cast on 4**
- q **Row 1-37:** Kfb, k across to 40 sts.
- q **Row 38-41:** Knit across
- q **Row 42-78:** Pssso, K across to 4 sts.
- q **Cast Off.** Weave in ends.

Heart In Granny's Favorite Dishie

Share some dishie love with a heart embossed dish cloth. It's a fun simple twist in Granny's favorite.

This pattern works best with solid colors.

 Project Type: Dish cloth
 Size: 7 inches square



- q **Cast on 4**
- q **Row 1:** Knit across
- q **Row 2-25:** K2, YO, K across to 28 sts.
- q **Row 26:** K2, YO, K11, P2, K Across
- q **Row 27:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 28:** K2, YO, K11, P4, K Across
- q **Row 29:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 30:** K2, YO, K11, P6, K Across
- q **Row 31:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 32:** K2, YO, K11, P8, K Across
- q **Row 33:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 34:** K2, YO, K11, P10, K Across
- q **Row 35:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 36:** K2, YO, K11, P12, K Across
- q **Row 37:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 38:** K2, YO, K11, P14, K Across
- q **Row 39:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 40:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K8, P16, K Across
- q **Row 41:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 42:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K6, P18, K Across
- q **Row 43:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 44:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K5, P18, K Across
- q **Row 45:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 46:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K5, P7, K2, P7, K Across
- q **Row 47:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 48:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K5, P5, K4, P5, K Across
- q **Row 49:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 50:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K5, P3, K6, P3, K Across
- q **Row 51-77:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across. Repeat to 4 on hook.
- q **Cast Off.** Weave in ends.

Smile on Granny's Favorite Dishie

This dishie will bring a smile to your face as you wash dishes and wipe counters. These are fun for sending smiles to friends and loved ones, too.

This pattern works best with solid colors.

Yarn Craft: Knit
 Skill Level: Easy a a a a
 Project Type: Dish cloth
 Size: 7 inches square

- q **Cast on 4**
- q **Row 1:** Knit across
- q **Row 2-26:** K2, YO, K across to 28.
- q **Row 27:** K2, YO, K8, P8, K Across
- q **Row 28:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 29:** K2, YO, K7, P12, K Across
- q **Row 30:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 31:** K2, YO, K7, P4, K2, P2, K2, P4, K Across
- q **Row 32:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 33:** K2, YO, K7, P5, K2, P2, K2, P5, K Across
- q **Row 34:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 35:** K2, YO, K7, P6, K2, P2, K2, P6, K Across
- q **Row 36:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 37:** K2, YO, K7, P7, K2, P2, K2, P7, K Across
- q **Row 38:** K2, YO, K Across
- q **Row 39:** K2, YO, K8, P20, K Across
- q **Row 40:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 41:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K6, P4, K2, P8, K2, P4, K Across
- q **Row 42:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 43:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K6, P4, K2, P6, K2, P4, K Across
- q **Row 44:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 45:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K6, P4, K2, P4, K2, P4, K Across
- q **Row 46:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 47:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K6, P4, K6, P4, K Across
- q **Row 48:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 49:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K6, P12, K Across
- q **Row 50:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 51:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K7, P8, K Across
- q **Row 52:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across
- q **Row 53-77:** K1, K2Tog, YO, K2Tog, K Across. Repeat to 4 on hook.
- q **Cast Off.** Weave in ends.
