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## SUPPLIES:

**Yarn:** RED, BLACK, GREY - *Remnants*

**Hook:** H / 8 / 5.00 mm

**Needle:** Yarn Needle for sewing

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Ch** = chain

**Dec** = decrease; crochet two stitches together

**Hdc** = half double crochet

**Hdc dec** = half double crochet decrease; crochet two stitches together

**Rnd** = round; work in the round

**Sc** = single crochet

**Sc dec** = single crochet decrease; single crochet two stitches together

**Sl st** = slip stitch

**St(s)** = stitch(es)

**\*instructions\*** = repeat the instructions written between the \*\* the number of times indicated after the second \*

## Star Trek Communicator Badge Cozy

Simple and nostalgic. This Star Trek Cozy will bring lots of smiles. Use the communicator badge on the cozy or as an appliqué on other projects.

Color is significant. Make the cozy the color of the department you wish to represent.

Yellow for Command (such as Captain Kirk)

Blue for Science and Medical (such as Spock and Dr. McCoy)

Red for Engineering & Security (such as Scotty or crew who die).

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**Yarn Craft:** Crochet  
**Skill Level:** Easy ✓ ✓ ✓ ✓  
**Project Type:** Cozy: Cup  
**Size:** 2" x 5" when folded flat  
**Gauge:** Hook: H. 4 sc and 4 rows = 1 inch  
**Yarn:** RED, GREY, BLACK: Medium Worsted Weight (4)

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### HDC COZY INSTRUCTIONS

*Red*

Hook: H

- Ch 33**
  - Rnd 1:** Sc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch made to form a ring. Hdc around. (33)
  - Rnd 2-6:** Hdc around. (33)
  - Rnd 7:** 31 hdc, sc, sl st.
- Finish off, weave in ends.  
 Attach Black to last st made.
- Rnd 8:** Ch 1, hdc around. (33)
  - Rnd 9:** 32 sc, sl st. (33)
  - Finish off and weave in ends.*
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### STAR TREK PIN INSTRUCTIONS

*Grey*

Hook: H

- Ch 10**
- Rnd 1:** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook. 6 sc, sl st dec. (8)
- Rnd 2:** Turn, skip a st. Sc dec, 3 sc, sl st dec. (5)
- Rnd 3:** Turn, skip a st, 3 sc, ch 4. (7)
- Rnd 4:** Turn, Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 4 sc, 4 sl st, ch 1 (last few sts will be worked on ends of previous rows). (10)
- Rnd 5:** Turn to foundation ch. Sl st across, ch 1. (10)
- Finish off and weave in ends.*
- Attach Black to back loop of last st made. Work in back loops only throughout.*
- Rnd 6:** Turn to area between legs. Work 7 sl sts, ch 2. (9)
- Rnd 7:** Turn to Row 3. Sl st across. Ch 1. (11)
- Rnd 8:** Turn to Row 5. Sl st across. Ch 2. Join with a sl st. (12)
